Which activities have been implemented?

1. Implement the Ophthalmology Residency Program

This year 11 resident doctors are being trained in CTEH, ophthalmology programme under the umbrella of NPEH (National Program for Eye Health) and the University of Sciences, Faculty of Medicine, Phnom Penh.

2. Diploma in Ophthalmic Nursing Training

This course is under the umbrella of Kampot RTC (Regional Training Centre), NPEH and Human Resources Department of Ministry of Health with 09 students nurses (2 students from Caritas Takeo Eye Hospital supported by CBM Germany, 2 students from Battambang Eye Care Centre supported by BOC, 2 students from Kampot Eye Unit supported by IRIS, 1 student from Rattankiri supported by ECF, 1 student from Pras Vihear supported by FHF, and 1 student from Koma Angkor Hospital supported by SEVA.

3. Support the CME for doctors and nurses at Takeo Eye Hospital

Supported 15 nurses and 2 doctors from Caritas Takeo Eye Hospital to attend Continuing Medical Education (CME) for Cambodia Ophthalmic Nurse Society on 7th -8th June at Naga World Hotel, Phnom Penh, Cambodia.

4. Continue the corneal ulcer intervention project

The Corneal Ulcer Intervention Project with 28 village health volunteers (VHV) at Sronge and Trea communes signed the MoU with all parties involve: Takeo PHD, OD Dunkeo, the two Health Centres, commune leaders, and CTEH. The handover of the management to Sronge and Trea Health Centres was done on 2nd Jan 2013 and will be monitored by CTEH through follow up meeting every two months. From January to June, 300 people were examined by VHVs, 276 people found with corneal abrasions and 275 abrasions healed, 4 case of corneal ulcer 2 cataracts, 2 pterygiums, 17 other diseases were referred to Takeo Eye Hospital for further treatment.

5. Monitoring Kirivong Vision Centre:

The MoU between the 3 parties was signed to eventual handover of Kirivong Vision Centre's management to Kirivong Referral Hospital that took effect since February 2012.

6. Purchase new equipments: observation tube, fundus camera and phaco machine, Zeiss Beamsplitter, and install electricity solar system.

- One set of Phaco machine (Carl Zeiss Visalis 100 Phacoemulsifier, Germany) was installed at CTEH and started functioning on 27th May 2013 until the end of June, 26 patients with cataract were performed with the Phacoemulsifier.
- One set of Fundus Camera (Carl Zeiss Visucam 500 Fungus Camera, Germany) was installed at CTEH and started functioning on 23th April 2013, until end of June, we performed 36 patients with 3 Fundus Photography (FP) and 33 Fluorescein Angiography (FLA).

7. Expansion Low Vision services, in collaboration with Krousar Thmey (KT)

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between CTEH and Krousa Thmey was signed and implemented.

8. Service Delivery

- Consultations at CTEH 29,015, (14,753 females and 1,913 girls)
- 3,441 in patient and 3,304 cases operated that have 2,148 cataract surgeries (1,387 females and 31 girls)

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- Cataract outcome in 2013, outcome at discharge 51.8% good, 40.8% borderline, 7.4% poor outcome – 1st follow-up after 1-3 weeks (77.9% presented for follow-up) with best VA 55.6% good, 37.1% borderline, 7.3% poor outcome. Total complication 5.3% (2.2% vitreous loss, 0.8% capsule rupture without vitreous loss, 0.6% Zonular dehiscence, 0.1% Striate keratopathy, 0.8% Endophthalmitis, and 0.9% others)
- 2,160 spectacles dispensed at CTEH (1,101 females and 110 girls)
- Consultations at Kirivong Vision Centre (KVC) 3,219 (1,621 females and 207 girls)
- 268 spectacles dispensed at KVC, 126 females
- Outreach screening: 4,456 patients (1,722 females and 943 girls) screened, 1,017 patients (649 females and 26 girls) referred from screening and 422 patients (286 females and 12 girls) arrived at CTEH for further treatment and surgery.
- 148 patients referred from CTEH to CDMD (66 females, 71 males, 4 boy, and 7 girls) for rehabilitation.
- 990 patients referred from CDMD to CTEH (503 females and 76 girls)

World Sight Day

The theme for the World Sight Day is Universal Eye Health to call to action is Get your Eyes Tested. The purpose of the event is to promote poor people especially vulnerable and people with disabilities to access free comprehensive eye care services at CTEH in order to reduce avoidable blindness in Cambodia. Were 415 patients got eye consultation and 28 patients got eye surgery. The rested (68 patients) will be operated on the following days.

Intensify the Community Ophthalmology Services

After CTEH integrated in to Caritas Cambodia, we expand primary eye care into other caritas program such as Caritas Prasvihea and Caritas Mondulkiri by provided PEC training to VHSG and VDA and also set up referral system by collaboration with Caritas regional, HC, RH (Eye Unit), and CTEH. After set up we got 12 patients referred for eye operation.

Partner meeting

Attend the monthly Pro-Technical Health Working Group (Pro-THWG) to discuss the health issues in Takeo Province. The attendance will also direct to motivate PHD to promote and advocate the needed supplies and personnel of CTEH in MoH and NPEH

Crosscutting Issue:

Promoted rights of people with disabilities to have more opportunity in accessing public service provisions and strengthen the referral networking, Caritas Takeo Eye Hospital (CTEH) renewed the bilateral annual agreement with Cambodia Development Mission for Disability (CDMD) and newly made a bilateral agreement with Cambodia Disability People Organization (CDPO) to promote affordable and available eye care services for all including disability, gender and children to further contribute to eliminating avoidable blindness, poverty reduction and discrimination in society.
